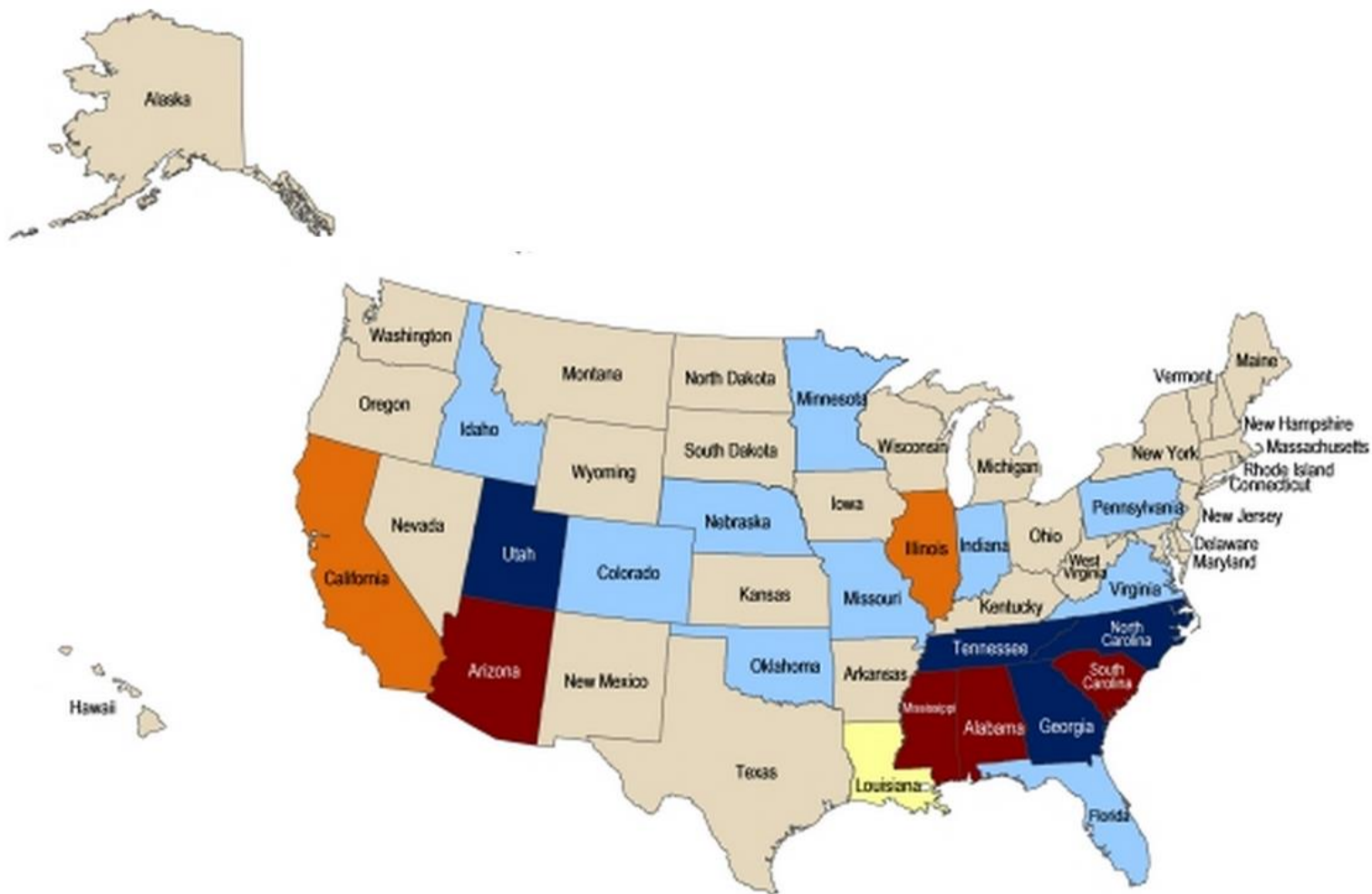




E-Verify [®] Legislation Map

- Use of E-Verify provides shield from sanctions
- E-Verify required for all employers of a specific size. See state for more detail.
- E-Verify Required for state public employers and/or contractors
- E-Verify required for all employers
- States, cities, counties and special districts prohibited from requiring E-Verify.

Note: Executive Order 12989 requires most federal contractors to use E-Verify effective 9/8/2009.
